1. About

Mmabana Community Outreach Project of Choma (Mmabana) is a non-profit community based organisation with its core values as a faith based organisation. Mmabana was established in 2008 and registered in 2009 (Registration number: ORS/-102/52/686).

We believe in collective, non-discriminating work between different stakeholders in order to uplift our community and thus play a direct role in poverty reduction strategies.

Mmabana works in two thematic areas: 1) **Child Protection and Development** and activities range from child labour awareness, education support and psychosocial support and 2) **Youth Empowerment through the provision of Life skills training** in Information and Communications Technology (ICT), leadership skills, self-awareness, sports and HIV/AIDS awareness and prevention measures.
